



## 2019 FNQGA Representative Players

### **Introduction:**

1. Each year the FNQGA conducts a range of competitions including the FNQGA Championships, the Pennants Competition, the champion of champions and the Peter Culley Golfer of the Year (GoTY).
2. The FNQGA also selects both individuals and teams to represent the district. Junior representative opportunities are not included here but are set out separately.
3. Representative players are only selected from players who have nominated for the FNQ Championships.

### **2019 GAQ Inter Association Teams Event:**

4. GAQ has not yet published details of this event, but it is usually played mid-week in early November. 18 holes foursomes and 18 holes fourball stroke play are played on the Monday, and 18 holes individual stroke play on the Tuesday.
5. Each district is represented by four players who must have current GA Handicaps, and must be members of a golf club which is affiliated with the district they represent. In recent years a handicap limit of 10.4 has been placed on participants.
6. The total team gross score is determined by adding the best team score in the foursomes, the best team score in the fourball and the best 3 of the 4 scores in the individual stroke rounds.

### **Selection for the Inter Association team:**

7. The FNQGA will select a team of four (4) representatives based on completed gross rounds at the FNQ Championships and selected club Open events.
8. Gross scores are adjusted to the equivalent of a DSR of 70. For example, a gross score of 75 on a course with an DSR of 72 will be adjusted to a gross score of 73. A gross score of 67 on a course with a DSR of 69 will be adjusted to a gross score of 68. Slope ratings and the ACR are not used.
9. Players will be selected for the team based on the average of their best eight (8) adjusted gross scores.
10. Players under the age of 18 are not eligible to participate. Players must also have a GA Handicap of 10.4 or less.

### **Assistance for the Inter Association team:**

11. The FNQGA historically receives financial assistance from Golf Australia to assist the team. Representatives will receive assistance with transport, nomination fees, uniform and accommodation as funds permit.

**2019 Queensland Open:**

12. Any FNQGA affiliated player who qualifies for a place in the main field of the Queensland Open is eligible to apply for assistance to fund travel, accommodation and entry fee. Such assistance will be at the sole discretion of the FNQGA and will be limited to an amount decided by the FNQGA.
13. No assistance will be considered for pre-qualifying events.

**Administration:**

14. All financial assistance will be by way of reimbursement. Players will be required to produce receipts for payments of actual expenses and will be reimbursed up to the limit of assistance.
15. Players must provide receipts within 14 days of completion of the event.
