

# **2020 PETER CULLEY GOLFER OF THE YEAR AWARDS**

## INTRODUCTION

1. The Peter Culley Golfer of the Year Awards (GoTY) were established to encourage male players of all skill levels and age groups to participate in a season long competition including the FNQGA Championships and member club open competitions.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2. Players must be male members of an FNQGA Club and have a valid GA Handicap.
- 3. Players are nominated automatically when they compete in the FNQ Champions.
- 4. Players must be able to play at all FNQGA Clubs without suspension or restriction.

## AWARDS:

- 5. Awards will be made for each grade and division.
- 6. The grades will be A grade for players up to and including a 10.4 GA Handicap, B grade for players between 10.5 and 17.4 GA Handicap (inclusive), and C Grade for players on or above 17.5 GA Handicap.
- 7. A player may only win one award. Players eligible for more than one award must choose which to accept. The other grade or division award(s) will then be awarded to other player(s).

### SCORING:

- 8. Points are awarded based on nett scores as follows:
  - **FNQGA** Championships

1<sup>st</sup> 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 8 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 6 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 4 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 2 points, participation 1 point. Club open competitions

1<sup>st</sup> 5 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 4 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 3 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 2 points, participation 1 point.

## RULES:

- 9. Points are only awarded for Events which adhere to the handicap ranges described in clause 6.
- 10. Points for players whose handicap changes grades will accrue separately in each grade.
- 11. Points only accrue once the host club submits the full nett scores for their open.

### ADMINISTRATION:

- 12. The FNQ Championship (mandatory) and up to one club Open event per club which meets the FNQGA's criteria is used in determining points
- 13. A list of eligible open competitions will be published on www.fnqgolf.com.au from time to time.
- 14. The FNQGA will promote each open competition by one or more links to the club's Facebook page. In return the club will promote the FNQGA Championships by one or more links to the FNQGA Facebook page.
- 15. At the completion of the open competition clubs must email a complete list of nett scores to match@fnqgolf.com.au. Points will not be allocated unless the list is received.
